Mental Health Intern Counselor Job Description

Mental Health Counselor:

Your job will be to engage with clients in an appropriate therapeutic manner, providing counseling services based on diagnosis and recommended treatment, and support you clients in all professional and possible ways, while following your clinical supervisor's close direct supervision.

Responsibilities:

- Therapies you will be providing include individual, couples, marriage, premarital, family, child, adolescent, and anything within your specialty and scope of practice (supervisor approval required).
- A set required of hours is needed for observation of sessions before engaging in sessions independently.
- You will be required to practice in a legal, ethical, and moral manner, as well as in accordance to our philosophy, mission statement and objectives therein.
- You will be required to be in weekly clinical supervision in accordance to Washington state law and related ethical standards. All therapeutic services will be provided in an assigned office, and in a timely manner.
- Therapy notes are required for each session and may be reviewed randomly to assess for best practice and overall professional and ethical adherence and development; as an intern, all your notes will be signed by your clinical supervisor.
- You are required to provide and maintain treatment plans for each client under the supervision of your clinical supervisor; your supervisor is required by Washington state law to create the treatment plan and diagnosis of a client.
- You are required to be prepared for all job duties, dressed professionally/appropriately, pursuant of professional and personal development.
- You are required to be open and flexible with changes that will inevitably be made as Beautiful Autism develops.
- You are required to be open to feedback and willing to provide feedback
- You may also be asked to perform specific duties related to the day-to-day business functioning of BA, such as cleaning.
